

Essentials Baskets Project



A Doorway to Hope is a local charity that assists working, low-income families experiencing financial and/or life crises and are unable to qualify for traditional means of assistance. Many of the "working poor" do not have extra resources to cover unexpected expenses or even basic household items like laundry detergent or bar soap. Each year ADTH adopts 75+ impoverished families in our community. Along with gifts, each adopted family receives an "Essentials Basket."

EACH BASKET CONTAINS:

- 1 bottle Laundry Detergent (50 oz. + or 35 ct. pods +)
- 1 bottle Dish Soap (20 oz. +)
- 2 spray bottles or canister of wipes of Anti-Bacterial Cleaner (Lysol/Clorox, 20 oz. +)
- Paper towels (2 rolls)
- Toilet Paper (8 rolls)
- Tissues (2 boxes)
- Face Masks (2 Adult, 2 Children)
- 1 bottle Hand Sanitizer (8 oz.+)
- Shampoo and Conditioner (12 oz. + each)
- Deodorant (1 men's, 1 women's 2.5 oz. +)
- Bar Soap (4 bars, 3 oz. +)
- 1 tube Toothpaste (4 oz. +)
- 1 box Band-Aids (20 ct. +)
- 1 tube Neosporin/Antibiotic Ointment (.5 oz. +)
- 1 bottle of Adult Tylenol
- 1 Roll of Aluminum Foil
- 1 box of Sandwich baggies

Optional Items:

- Baby Items (Diapers, Wipes)
- Feminine Items (Tampons, Pads)
